IRENE FOUNTAS AND GAY SU PINNELL have developed an intervention model and materials for grades 3–6 that can be implemented in any school. A teacher works with three students for a period of 18 weeks with the goal of bringing them to grade level. It is designed to supplement a good classroom literacy program and Reading Recovery® as part of a comprehensive literacy approach.



IN 6 DAYS OF PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT, educators learn how to implement structured lessons that include phonics/word study and the reading of leveled texts.

DAILY INSTRUCTION IN LEVELED LITERACY INTERVENTION 3–6

- Provides a daily 30-minute lesson for a small group of children
 - Combines reading, writing, and specific work on sounds, letters, and words
 - Gives explicit attention to the features of nonfiction & fiction texts
 - Provides explicit teaching of effective strategies for writing and uses writing to extend understanding of texts and of words
 - Emphasizes teaching for comprehending strategies
- Provides explicit teaching of effective and efficient strategies for expanding vocabulary

LEVELED LITERACY INTERVENTION 3–6 FEATURES

- Fast-paced lessons that include explicit instruction in phonemics/phonics, vocabulary, fluency, and comprehension
- Daily lesson guides with prescribed sequences of texts
- Instructional interactions between teachers and students with a 3:1 student-teacher ratio
